PROGRAMMING IDEA

Sticky Wall

You will need: Contact Paper and Painter's Tape

MONTHLY STANDARDS REVIEW

Provincial Standards Review:

Standard 8: Incidents

Agencies must report to the authority the following incidents immediately of learning of the occurrence. An incident is defined as follows:

An emergency evacuation; unexpected program closure; an intruder in the provider's residence; a serious illness or injury to a child that requires the provider to request emergency health care and/or requires the child to remain in hospital overnight; an error in the administration of medication by the provider of other resident; the death of a child; an unexpected absence of a child from the program (ie: lost child); a child removed from a program by a non-custodial parent or guardian; an allegation of physical, sexual, emotional abuse and/or neglect of a child by a provider or another resident of the home; the commission by a child of an offence under the Act of Canada or Alberta; and/or a child left unattended in the provider's home outside of the provider's operating hours.

Accreditation Standards Review:

1.2 Child care programs demonstrate respectful, positive interactions and communications with children.

Indicators:

- e. Use a continuum of developmentally and age appropriate strategies when guiding children within a caring, respectful, and nurturing environment.
- f. Discuss behaviour expectations with children at a developmental level they understand.
- g. Use observation techniques to identify causes of challenging behaviours and modify the environment and supervision to promote positive behaviours.
- h. Support children in engaging in positive behaviours and expressing their feelings in socially acceptable ways.
- i. Guide children as they begin to develop problem solving skills.
